Characters: Peter, John Scripture text: John 20:1-22 Props: chair/bench Setting: Just outside doorway; and then inside Length: 5 minutes

(We hear the sounds of running, panicky voices. PETER and JOHN are running. Before they get to the door, PETER pulls up, winded.)

PETER: Would you wait up—I'm pretty sure I pulled something—John ... John.

JOHN: Hurry up then...

(He waits at the door, until PETER catches up.)
